- Information on the Targeted Intervention Fund was reported to the group, as well as the €1,500 available to the Alcohol subgroup in 2019 for it's activities
- Ministerial funded research is being led out by D12 LDATF, a meeting request for that working group to reconvene will be requested

Strategic Goals of CCLDATF Alcohol Strategy

- The meeting continued to discuss the current status of activities under the strategy. It was agreed that each member should read the strategic document and send a priority under each goal to the Co-ordinator ahead of the next meeting to progress the prioritisation and work-plan for the group in 2019.
- There was a discussion on the legalities of BYOB functions, the group outlined a number of hotspots where street drinking takes place and a request for any legal queries on the new legislation to be compiled and sent to the Garda representative.
- There has been test purchasing in the area conducted by the Gardai and all premises tested passed, responsible server training has been undertaken by licensed premises since last year.
